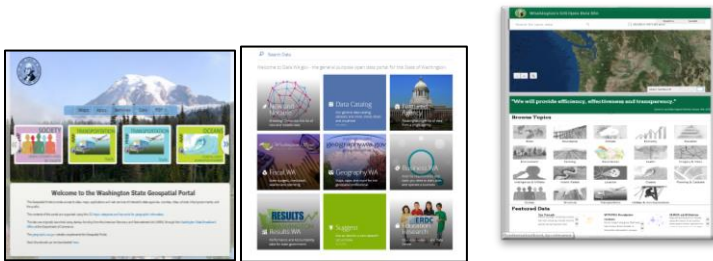




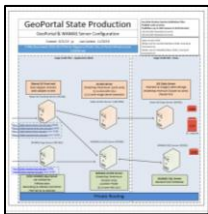
Geography Portal

geography.wa.gov = is a publically available website that allows access to all state agency resources related to GIS. This is maintained by [Geospatial Program Office](#) for the benefit of all. There are no charges billed to agencies for this service. I don't collect stats on usage of this portal but we could.



Open Data Bridge

[wa-geoservices](#) + [data.wa.gov](#) = [geo.wa.gov](#) are publically available websites that allows access to state agency GIS data, maps and applications that are published to the cloud by state agencies. These two services are hosted on Esri's ArcGIS On-Line. The **Open Data Bridge** actually links the Socrata [data.wa.gov](#) platform with the ArcGIS On-Line data holdings. These services are maintained by [Geospatial Program Office](#) for the benefit of all. There are no charges billed to agencies for these services. No statistics are collected since this is an aggregator of information from many federated sites across state government.



GeoPortal (shared Geospatial infrastructure)

<http://geoservices.wa.gov/arcgis/rest/services/> is the physical, shared GIS infrastructure that hosts the state agencies 110+ GIS data, imagery and services that are used by 27 state agencies. This is an Allocated Service that the agencies receive funding for and in turn pay for the service. WAMAS - Washington Master Addressing Services

Are addressing services (API's) that are available for use by state agencies. These applications are hosted on the GeoPortal (see above) and are available for use to 57 agencies. This an allocated service that agencies pay for out of their budgets. Statistics are collected and posted to the WAMAS website.
