GOAL \$235,000

- Getting closer to our goal... we've raised \$180,250
 - **Short \$54,750**

Rundown on imagery data contributors

- Agencies/Universities = \$122,750 (Mil, OCIO, RCO, DNR, ECY, UW, DOT)
- Counties = \$57,500 (Asotin, Chelan, Grant, Kittitas, Mason, Pacific, Pierce, Skamania, Stevens)
- OCIO = \$50,000 to cover 10 TB of disk storage for 12 months
- DNR is contributing time to process the statewide 1 ft. imagery data used stand up the REST service and distribute physical data to contributing counties only

Where we're short...

- The counties still shy \$54,750
- The physical data will only be distributed to the 9 contributing counties
- Non-contributing counties will have access to vendor service & the REST service published by the state

The devils are in the details

- 2 Responses to RFI
- Valtus = Responded to Requirements Matrix with 10 NO's
- Google = Responded to Requirements Matrix with 12 NO's

- Major sticking point with both vendors ?
 - *Access to the data in perpetuity*
 - *Must meet 3 year purchase of service before you can keep it*

RFQ Next Steps

- *RFQ will not be released until funding short fall is filled*
- Need commitment from contributors that data access conditions are acceptable (previous slide)
- *Need to draft RFQ mandatory requirements that will guide the selection of the successful vendor*
- 3 – 4 weeks to process RFQ
- *WaTech can purchase off a successful quote for up to 3 years but can't commit to more than yearly service renewals*
- Contributing partners agreement will be drafted with expectations and deliverables outlined
