Project: Healthcare Enforcement and Licensing Modernization Solution (HELMS) Project

**Description:** The Washington State Healthcare Enforcement and Licensing Modernization Solution (HELMS) is a new business solution that will replace the outdated Integrated Licensing and Regulatory System (ILRS). HELMS will transform licensing and enforcement processes and the department's interactions with participants and stakeholders. HELMS will improve data security, support electronic records management, and improve provider, patient, and employer access to information.

## **Business Problem to be solved:**

- Replace outdated legacy system –ILRS
- Support the licensing and regulatory needs of:
  - Almost 500,000 healthcare professionals practicing in 86 professions across 359 credential types
  - 2,500 educational and training programs across four educational and training program types
  - Nearly 12,000 facilities across 21 facility types
