SUBJECT: Information Technology (IT) Biennial Performance Report

Per RCW 43.105.220, the Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO) is required to prepare a state performance report on Information Technology (IT). The report highlights progress made implementing the state strategic information technology plan from July 1, 2017, to June 30, 2019.

We determined the report delivered on March 5, 2020, contained a sorting error within Table-1 on page 13. The attached report is an updated version with Table-1 corrected. The sorting error did not change the overall state IT expenditures, however, did swing expenditures between category "Other" and "External Labor." Upon further examination we conclude the sorting error on Table-1 does not impact analysis contained in other sections of the report.
