





SUBJECT: **Additional Information Technology Projects Subject to the IT Investment Pool**

We are submitting this memo in compliance with Section 701(12) of the 2020 Supplemental Operating Budget:

The office of the state chief information officer, in consultation with the office of financial management, may identify additional projects to be subject to this section, including projects that are not separately identified within an agency budget. The office of the state chief information officer must report on July 1 and December 1 each calendar year, beginning July 1, 2020, any additional projects to be subjected to this section that were identified in the previous six month period to the legislative fiscal committees.

During the past six months the OCIO, in consultation with the OFM, identified no additional projects to be subjected to Section 701 of 2020 Supplemental Operating Budget.
