**SUBJECT:** **Suspended and Terminated Information Technology Projects**

Per Section 701(11) of the 2020 Supplemental Operating Budget, we are submitting this report of information technology (IT) projects under OCIO oversight suspended or terminated between January 1 and June 20, 2020.

During the past six months, three IT projects subject to 701 of the 2020 Supplemental Operating Budget were terminated due to a combination of project resources being redirected to COVID-19 efforts, agency budget reductions and new legislation removing the project from 701 oversight or significantly changing the project scope.

One non-IT Investment Pool project was suspended due to project resources being redirected to COVID-19 response efforts. One non-IT Investment Pool project was terminated in light of higher agency priorities and increasing project budget, schedule and work efforts as well as increasing project risk.
