**SUBJECT:** **Information Technology (IT) Biennial Performance Report**

Per RCW 43.105.220, the Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO) is required to prepare a state performance report on Information Technology (IT). Based on agency portfolios, this Technology Performance Report highlights progress made implementing the state strategic information technology plan across two biennia covering the period from July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2017. The executive summary describes factors that delayed reporting for the 2013-15 Biennium.

With OCIO guidance, the state instituted activities to better address risks and enabled progression through the technology strategic plan. The report provides insight into the health and status of state IT investments and shares progress toward electronic access to public information and services.

Included in the narrative is a one-page graphic of the IT strategic plan for 2017-21 that summarizes the statewide mission, goals, and objectives for the use of information technology over the next two biennia.
