SUBJECT: CONTINUED IT PROJECT GATED FUNDING OVERSIGHT IN 2021-23 BIENNIUM

Pursuant to Section 701 of the enacted 2021-23 operating budget, the Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO), in consultation with the Office of Financial Management (OFM), is placing the following information technology (IT) projects under gated funding oversight.

The OCIO and OFM recognize that these projects were not subject to the conditions, limitations and review requirements of the information technology investment pool in the 2021-23 enacted budget. However, these projects were under gated funding oversight in the 2019-21 biennium and meet at least one of the following criteria: (1) continue to be assessed as elevated or high risk by the OCIO; (2) have had significant scope, schedule and/or budget changes; or (3) are highly visible projects with multiple external stakeholder groups and community impacts.
