## SUBJECT: ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE GUIDELINES

<u>RCW 19.360</u> authorizes state agencies to use electronic signatures to conduct their business unless otherwise prohibited. However, the decision to use or rely on electronic signatures is one that each agency must make on their own, based on a business assessment and risk analysis.

To support state agencies in their evaluations, I am pleased to announce the publication of the <u>Electronic</u> <u>Signature Guidelines</u>. The guidelines were developed with the support of a cross-agency workgroup and are intended to:

- Help agencies determine if, and to what extent, their agency will implement and rely on electronic records and electronic signatures,
- Provide agencies with information they can use to establish policy or rules governing their use and acceptance of electronic signatures, and
- Provide direction to agencies for sharing their policies with the Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO), as required by state law.
