WHY The OCIO holds transparency as a core principle for the investment in, and the on-going use of, technology in Washington State.

While committed to enhancing our office's transparency, the OCIO is also opening up the view into technology activities statewide, in particular with regard to the many state agencies and institutions for which the OCIO has oversight responsibilities. To that end, the OCIO is crafting new policy that elevates transparency to a requirement of technology portfolio practices—from planning and development, through implementation and ongoing management. Through the fall of 2013 OCIO staff will work with technology staff at state agencies and higher education to develop a transparency policy that will be presented to the Technology Services Board for consideration.
